1. Is always on time to each lesson and is courteous and quiet on the way to and from lessons.
2. Attends every lesson possible, with all of their materials, because missing lessons means falling behind.
3. Prepares their instrument quickly for the lesson and then waits quietly for the lesson to start.
4. Does not play their instrument in the hallways, or any other inappropriate time.
5. Never talks or plays their instrument during the lesson unless asked to do so.
6. Takes proper care of their instrument and never lets anyone else handle or play it.
7. Practices for 100 minutes per week. That's only 20 minutes, 5 days of the week. Practice makes perfect!
8. Keeps up on their regular classroom work because falling grades means having to quit band.
9. Agrees to stay in band for the 2 month trial period. If you don't give band a try for at least 2 months you won't know if you are going to succeed!
